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### INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANTS' REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Board of Commissioners, the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) and management of the Everett Housing Authority, solely to perform the agreed-upon procedures, as prescribed by the Massachusetts Department of Housing and Community Development for the year ended September 30, 2018. The Everett Housing Authority's management is responsible for management decisions and functions and maintaining internal controls, including monitoring ongoing activities. This agreed-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of those parties specified in this report. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures and the associated findings are presented in the Schedule of Agreed-Upon Procedures included in this report.

We were not engaged to and did not conduct an examination, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on the effectiveness of the Everett Housing Authority's internal controls or on compliance with certain provisions of laws, regulations, contracts, and grant agreements. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.
